

RWGA 18 Hole League Minutes - March 3, 2015 Meeting

1. Special Report - Jen Bray introduced Rob Hipps, President of the Englewood Cancer Foundation (ECF). Rob thanked the RWGA 18 Hole League for the contributions we have made to the ECF. Our league has been the largest donor for the past two years. ECF has helped 78 people with cancer over the last year. \$75,000 has been distributed including to a youngster with leukemia and a 94-year-old individual who would not have had surgery if not for this assistance. The ECF has an all-volunteer staff, and the organization is a 501 3C non-profit. A question was asked as to how much money goes to entertainment. Rob indicated they have one fundraiser and two to three oncology educational dinners for cancer survivors and caregivers.
