Attached are the drawings that show examples of water hazard ball placement. The club also asks that we keep golf carts 30 yards away from the greens.

Rick Anderson demonstrated relief when the ball is on the cart path:

If ball is unanimously considered in the middle of path, player can choose right or left side of path, otherwise closest relief of path. Place stance off of cart path take 2 club lengths then mark with a tee, drop the ball if it rolls closer to hole you must re drop, 2 tries then you may place ball. Relief is not mandatory player can choose.
