1. Max per hole calculation -The formula is: par for the hole plus 2 strokes plus any dots-handicap strokes player is to receive. This adjusted score will be posted in the POST column on score cards. RWGA members are required to adjust their score as we have done in the past.

2. Handicap is now based on the 8 best scores over a rolling 12 months. The max handicap is 54. The RWGA league can adjust the maximum handicap, at this time the max is 40 in our league.

3. Posting should be done the same day as play. A weather factor is included in the new program and it can impact the average players scores.

Joni Katz put first motion on the floor that members post their own scores, Micki Shea second motion, the motion did not pass.
